

Leading Design Experts and Business Professionals Judging Design for Asia Award 2008

633 entries from around the world compete in three award categories for Asia's premier design awards

HONG KONG, 10 October 2008 – Hong Kong Design Centre (HKDC) today announced 16 of the world's premier design experts from Europe and Asia have been selected to judge the region's most sought after design awards, the Design for Asia Award (DFA Award) 2008.

This year, the esteemed DFA Award received 633 entries representing 12 countries including China, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Japan, Korea, Singapore, Thailand and from as far as Europe, the UK and the US. All entries will be judged by the expert judging panel on their design, influence, and commercial success in Asia.

The DFA Award, initiated by HKDC, seeks to raise awareness among business and the public about the value of good design as an essential component in great business, and in creating a sustainable, better quality of life for all. For the past five years, it has been presented to companies and designers around the world that have achieved business success through good design that has a notable impact on Asia.

The world-renowned professionals and experts in the judging panel represent a variety of business, professional, academic and design disciplines with experience both locally and internationally. They will select winners for the Award across three award categories:

DFA Gold Award DFA Silver Award DFA Bronze Award Merit Recognition	Up to three of the best works from 18 design disciplines including apparel & accessories design, communication design, product & industrial design, and environment design will be awarded a Gold, Silver, or Bronze Award, or Merit Recognition
DFA Grand Award	The DFA Grand Award recognises the best designs among all categories based on their design excellence, influence in Asia and commercial success. A maximum of ten designs will be awarded
DFA Special Awards	This is for design solutions that excel in fields beyond the definitions of the traditional categories and have been demonstrative in improving quality of life, or inspiring future design development. The following three special awards will be awarded: - DFA Special Award for Sustainability - DFA Special Award for Culture - DFA Special Award for Technology
